Guidelines for Online Registration - Admission 2018

In order to ensure uniformity and to regulate the admission procedure in Sikkim Government College, Human Resource Development Department (Directorate of Higher Education) hereby notifies the following guidelines.

- I. Registration of students in Sikkim Government College(s) shall be done centrally through Online Mode. The students can log in to www.sgcregistration.com or through RUSA SIKKIM ADMISSION Mobile Application which can be downloaded from iOS and Android Platform.
- II. **INTAKE CAPACITY:**
 - a. Following shall be college wise Intake Capacity for the Academic Session 2018 – 19.
 - b. For Sanskrit College, Samdong; B.Ed College, Soreng; Sikkim Institute of Higher Nyingma Studies (SHEDA) Pangthang the Admission Dates and Intake Capacity shall be updated in www.sgcregistration.com at the time of admission.

- III. Students seeking admission in these colleges has to register his/her personal as well as academic details in the online registration portal. Documents like:
- a. Certificate of Identification or Sikkim Subject or Residential Certificate.
 - b. Community Certificate
 - c. Disability Certificate, should be mandatorily uploaded by the applicant whichever is applicable, while submitting the application online.

1. The Admission to all the Government Colleges will be given as per the intake capacity mentioned above.
2. A central online committee at the Directorate of Higher Education, including representative from respective colleges will be constituted for monitoring, supervision and addressing the discrepancies if any during the admission process.
3. Merit List will be based on the policy of best of 4 subjects in case of ISC and best of 5 in case of CBSE & other State Boards. Based on the eligibility rule table (Annexure I) the marks obtained in the subject for which the candidate has applied will mandatorily be a part of best of 4 or best of 5 subjects for calculating the merit of the candidate.
4. Candidates other than Certificate of Identification or Sikkim Subject or Residential Certificate must have at least 70% aggregate to apply for admission.
5. Vocational Students must have scored 60% to apply for Arts and Commerce courses provided they have passed the compulsory subject (Refer Annexure I) in 10 + 2. Further there is no cut of percentage to apply for Vocational Subjects provided the candidate have pass mark.
6. Category wise Reservation on Intake Capacity:
 - a. The 85% of the Intake Capacity of all the Government Colleges will be reserved for Certificate of Identification or Sikkim Subject Holders.
 - b. 10% of the Intake Capacity will be allotted to Residential Certificate Holders. Only the certificates issued in pursuance of Home Department Notification No: 23/Home/2015 dated 15/05/2015 will be considered valid.
 - c. 5% intake capacity will be allotted to wards of Regular State Government Employees (Non-Local); Central Government Employees, Army Personal, CPMF transferred or working in Sikkim at the time of admission of their wards, belonging to outside the state.
 - d. 3% of the total Intake Capacity of each programme of all the Colleges will be reserved for the Differently Able student for allotment of seats on the basis of merit list generated.

Note: If the seats in any of the category remain vacant it would be accordingly crated to Certificate of Identification, Sikkim Subject and Residential Certificate Holder. Further, if the seats are still vacant it would then be considered to Regular State Government Employees (Non-Local); Central Government Employees, Army Personal, CPMF transferred or working in Sikkim at the time of admission
7. A student can opt for all the colleges and a maximum of 2 courses per college provided they are eligible to opt for the course and college (Refer Annex I). It is advisable that the candidate opt for at least 2 subject preferences per college to maximize the chance of seat allocation.
8. The students who have studied Science in their 10 + 2 can apply for B.Sc, B.A., B.Com or B.Voc based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
9. The students who have studied Humanities in their 10 + 2 can apply for B.A. or B.Voc based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
10. The students who have studied Commerce in their 10 + 2 can apply for B.Com, B.A. or B.Voc based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
11. The students who have studied Commerce in their 10 + 2 can apply for B.Com, B.A. or B.Voc based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
12. The students who have studied Vocational in their 10 + 2 can apply for B.Voc, B.Com, B.A. or B.Sc (Computer Science) based on the eligibility rule table (Refer Annexure I).
13. Seat allocation is completely based on Preference, Category and Marks Percentage. Merit List will be generated as per the preference set by the applicant followed by the Category the candidate belongs to followed by the Marks Percentage scored by the candidate.
14. Compartmental Students of academic year 2017-18 are not eligible to apply. However candidates who cleared the improvement exams prior to admission for 2018 can apply.

15. Candidates who will pay the prospectus fee through Demand Draft must upload the scan copy of the Demand Draft at the time of registration and submit the same during the time of Admission.
